Buckhorn Family Camp Use Agreement

COPIES OF DRIVERS LICENSES OF ALL ADULT FAMILY MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED AT YOUR ARRIVAL.

1. All Check-in will be completed via email. You will receive your cabin number and any instructions related to your stay via email or in printed format in your cabin.
2. Vehicles shall be driven and parked only in the designated areas and driven in accordance with the posted speed limit of 15 mph, max. Vehicle use should be limited on the camp property in favor of walking whenever possible. PLEASE DRIVE CAREFULLY.
3. The use of alcohol, recreational or illicit drugs, fireworks, firearms, ammunition, and explosives is prohibited. Offenders will be asked to leave.
4. All buildings at Buckhorn are non-smoking facilities. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings. Open fires may be built only in the campfire areas and may be restricted to burn bans based on weather conditions. It is understood that both Buckhorn and groups must comply with all lawful orders of appropriate fire control officials. Please check with Buckhorn staff before lighting a campfire.
5. Pets (other than service animals) are not permitted on camp property.
6. All guests are expected to respect the rights of other guests. Quiet hours are observed between the hours of 10:30 PM and 7:00 AM. Buckhorn reserves the right to require that the group remove from the property any persons in, or in any way connected with, the group who, in the sole opinion of Buckhorn Camp, are creating a disturbance or who are otherwise disrupting activities.
7. Buckhorn Camp does not provide medical supervision, treatment, maintenance, or dispensing of medications for groups. These responsibilities belong to the group.
8. Guests agree to supervise and to assume full control and responsibility for any persons, entities or things that uses Buckhorn as a part of the group. Guests agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Buckhorn and its past, present, and future members, directors, officers, employees, agents, and independent contractors and their successors, assigns and heirs from and against any harm and/or claim made by any third part arising out of or in any way connected with the group's actions and/or failure(s) to act in respect of its use of Buckhorn Camp.
9. Guests acknowledges that activities or events at Buckhorn may involve a test of a person's

physical and mental limits and may carry the potential for injury or loss. The risks may include but are not limited to those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, altitude, weather, condition of participants, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people, and lack of hydration.

10. Please show appreciation and demonstrate good stewardship by avoiding damage to trees and trails. Dispose of all litter and trash in proper containers and help save energy by turning off lights and keeping doors and windows closed.

11. Buckhorn is not responsible nor does our insurance cover loss or damage to personal property. Cars should be kept locked. Lost and found articles will be available for pickup up to six weeks following the group's departure.

12. The camp kitchen is for the use of Buckhorn employees. If you need assistance from the kitchen please ask a Buckhorn Staffer.

13. Payment in full is required by the arrival of your stay.

14. Due to the current pandemic climate, guests may not utilize or congregate in public access areas including Buckhorn Lodge or Elkhorn Lodge. Guests are permitted to use outdoor recreational equipment while following appropriate social distancing guidelines.
